However, few would disagree that the average person thinks they are good enough, and they may well be. Our challenge is to capture them for Christ for ours is a righteousness which must exceed the righteousness of all others...

BURNS AFTERNOON TEA:

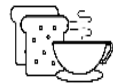
Thank you to all who attended and
