For all Christians, and as you have read in our Psalm and our Gospel reading; for all of God's people the good life is not enough. There has been a great emphasis on goodness and rightly so; but all believers should lead an exemplary life.

Yet there is a danger in thinking that good living is all that we need. Goodness can be very selfish. Think of the meticulous moral practices of the Pharisees and the expressions recorded in the New Testament from their lips like: "I have kept these things from my youth up," said the religious leader to Jesus in Luke 18:12. I think we would agree that these are all examples of a truly selfish righteousness.

However, few would disagree that the average person thinks they are good enough, and they may well be. Our challenge is to capture them for Christ for ours is a righteousness which must exceed the righteousness of all others...

The Greatest Showman will be shown in the Wynd Centre on Wednesday, February 15th.


