

The Psalmist set the scene for today in verse 8 when he says: "You have set my feet in a spacious place." This not only speaks of how he felt in the presence of God's world, but also speaks of the enormity of God's world.

The power and the wisdom and the love of God are infinite and God has set our feet in a large room and he will give us enormous help through Jesus who said, "I am the Way..." All the religions of the world reveal many ways in which people have tried to get right with God. But there is only one Redeemer - Jesus! He is the Way and the Truth. He is, in his own person, the Revelation of God.

But the Kingdom was not just about to come, it was "at hand" in the sense of being already present in the person and ministry of Jesus. The opportunity to respond to the Kingdom was available to those who were willing to receive Jesus and indeed, believing in him leads to a whole inner transformation by which a person both sees and enters the "house of many rooms."


