The story of Goliath with his sword and David with his sling is an illustration of great power without control set against little power with outstanding control. It is also, very largely, the story of men and women whose names are unknown who gave their lives on the battlefields of history, not to create new knowledge, not to disseminate new ideas, not to invent new gadgets or bring about some new way of life. But to preserve from destruction the things that they knew in their hearts to be worth preserving.

If we need to be reminded of the dimensions of this evil, you only have to look at the crosses in a military cemetery. But when you look closer; you will see more than the dimension of evil in the cross, you will see also the dimensions of goodness, for the cross is the symbol, not only of the injustice involved in putting to death a man called Jesus who did not deserve to die but of the full extent of God's love for each one of us.

PRAYER: *Help us by your great love to come to the assistance of the afflicted, to relieve the needy and destitute, to share the burdens of the heavy laden, and to see you in all who are suffering in our world: for his sake, who loved us, and gave himself for us, Jesus Christ our Lord ...*

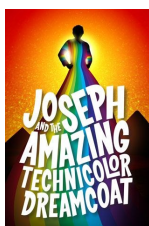
