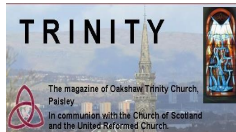

purchase them from the Wynd reception.

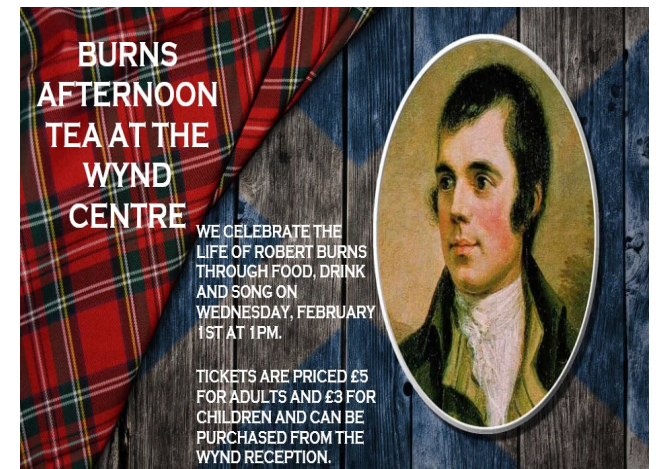


TWO O'CLOCK CLUB:
