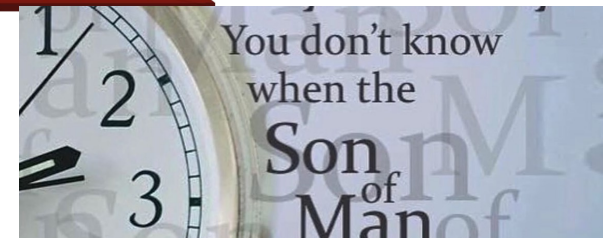

The word, "adventure" is just an extension of the word, "advent". Today, we again celebrate a coming adventure which is beyond our control.

In translation, advent is a Latin word for the English word, "come." The last words in the Bible are the words, "Come Lord Jesus." From this we can see that the word advent isn't only referring to the four Sundays of Advent.

In the Bible, there are essentially three "comings." The past: the coming of God to earth in the person of Jesus of Nazareth. The future: the coming of God at the end of history in the Second Coming. And the present: God coming to us daily for the people who have eyes of faith to see.

You never know who God will bring to you today, or what God will do with your life today. Every day is always an adventure to come to God.
