Jesus would no longer be physically present with his followers but he would, however, still be with them through the Holy Spirit. Through the indwelling Holy Spirit, they would become his Body, equipped and empowered to be his witnesses in the world and to pass on the torch of faith down through the ages to a congregation of his people met here today in Paisley!

Those promises were fulfilled on the day of Pentecost. The mission of Jesus was to continue through his apostles by the enabling power of the Spirit. The message that the crowd heard was about "the great things that God has done" (2v11).

To explain what was happening, Peter quoted from the Old Testament prophet Joel about the promise of God's Spirit, ending with the words:

"And then, whoever calls out to the Lord for help will be saved" (Acts v.21).

Pentecost was one of the results of what God had done through Jesus. It was the beginning-point for believers in experiencing the fullness of God and in becoming Christ's witnesses in the world.








NEXT SUNDAY:
