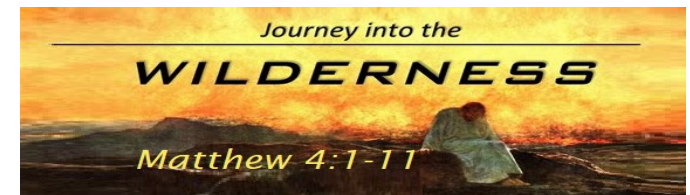

THE BENEDICTION & DRESDEN AMEN



Because the temptations are of such great importance, they are placed at the beginning of Jesus' ministry.

The first temptation appeals to our appetite to which Jesus responds that we do not live by bread alone. The second appeals to the spectacular and our desire to be entertained. But Jesus in all that he did tried to keep the miraculous part of his ministry very low key. In the third, Satan offered Jesus all the kingdoms of the world if Jesus would worship him. However, Jesus by his response made it clear that though Satan thought he was prince of this age, God would have the ultimate victory.

Jesus would then go on to redeem the world by his blood; not by the Sermon on the Mount or the Golden Rule, and not through his life, but his death...

Prayer: *Holy Spirit of God, inspire us by all that is good that we might be enabled to resist every evil and to live no longer for ourselves alone, but for Christ who reigns forever ...*

These short services followed by coffee or tea are held weekly in the Wynd Apse.

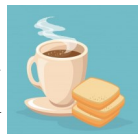
