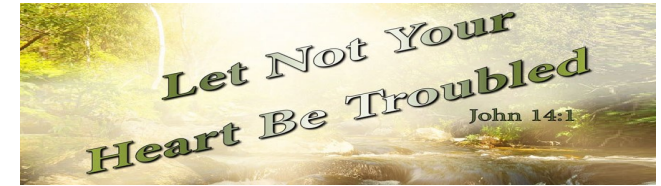

## THE BENEDICTION & DRESDEN AMEN



*A long time ago the psalmist was troubled about his heart. He voiced this prayer in Psalm 22:14: "My heart has turned to wax; it has melted within me."*

*Our hearts are a concern to every one of us, considered both physically and spiritually. If a person worked as hard as their heart, imagine what they could get done. The spiritual heart is no less important than the physical. Our heart, in the same way the Bible uses it, means in most places, the centre of the human soul or spiritual being. The Lord himself stressed the importance of the heart in our spiritual relationship to God which is why he said to Philip: "The words I say to you I do not speak on my own authority. Rather, it is the Father, living in me, who is doing his work."*

*All Christians need to keep their hearts right and ought to be just as eager to keep their spiritual hearts in just as good condition as the physical one.*
