One of the most notable things about this man is that he walked straight into the face of danger and death. He didn't have to. He could have slipped quite easily into the wings of history and been forgotten. And yet in another sense he did have to.



This will be held after the Sunday Service on April 16th.




WYND FILM SHOW:
