Today's Gospel reading has the only two occurrences of Jesus being described as the "Lamb of God". John had reluctantly baptised Jesus believing that Jesus, the sinless one, should baptise him (Matthew 3.13-17). It was at this point we hear John describing Jesus as "the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world" (v.29 & v.36).

The Jews of that time knew about sin; no matter how reluctant they might be in practice to acknowledge their own particular sins. They also understood about sacrifices as they played a large part in their religious worship acknowledging that something had to be done about the guilt of sin as indicated in our reading from Isaiah.

It was this prior knowledge that inspired the disciples to follow Jesus with the realisation that as the "Lamb of God", he was sufficient for the saving of lost souls...

<u>Prayer</u>: Lord Jesus, may your law of love and sacrifice be written in all our lives that we may rightly call you Lord and go forth to be your witnesses in the world.

CEILIDH:




