SERMON NOTES

An Unexpected Encounter

When Jesus first called Peter to follow, he had said, "I will make you fishers of men." He really wanted to be with Jesus. But - what could he say to Jesus after his denial? What might Jesus say to him?

Jesus didn't say to Peter, I'm ashamed of you! In some ways Peter might have expected that. But instead, Jesus says, "Simon, son of John, do you truly love me more than these?" Behind those words lie all of Peter's claims and professions of loyalty.



Jesus said I still have work for you to do. Feed my lambs! Remember, Simon, what I said about my sheep, the people who believe in me. "I came so that they might have life and have it to the full" (Jn.10.10).

The risen Lord Jesus is with us today, asking us that same question - "Do you love me?" We certainly want him to be our Saviour in eternity, but are hesitant about the implications of having him as Lord here and now... And here is Jesus saying to us, "Do you love me?"
