**SERMON NOTES**

*"... He knows the way that I take;  
When he has tested me, I shall come forth as  
gold"(Job.23:10)*

In our readings today we meet two very different men. Both are rich and influential. Both are asking serious questions of God about life, purpose and destiny. Both are being probed. The elder is probed by God's great adversary (within certain limits as set by God). The adversary is out to prove that Job's godliness is self-serving. He is proved wrong.

The younger is being probed by Jesus who listens with tender concern and affection as he is addressed as "good" with the question "what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus then watches with sorrow as the young man walks off, unwilling to accept what Jesus tells him and continues in ways that are self-serving.

One man trusted God while the other turned on his heel. Whose path shall we follow today? We have a choice. God will hold us to it.
