*Bartimaeus was blind who was healed by Jesus. Yet, Bartimaeus could see better than many of the people around him who had the gift of sight. He knew who Jesus was. He called him Jesus, Son of David. He realized that he needed to come*

*to Jesus for mercy.*

*We live in a world where people are blind to Jesus. Some, like the rich young man are blinded by their wealth. Some, like the religious leaders are blinded by their pride and their mindset.*
