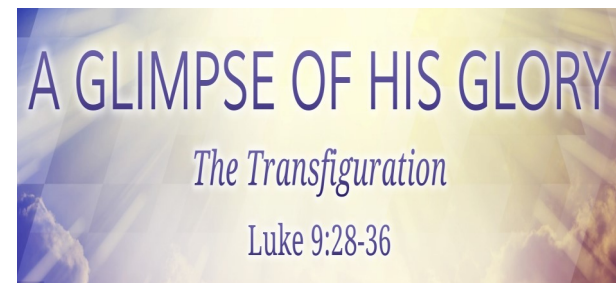

SERMON NOTES



Jesus changed before them! His face changed, even his clothes looked different – they were so white that they dazzled them by their brilliance becoming whiter than white.

In our analytical minds we are bound to ask, did Jesus really change, or was it his friends who changed? My answer is that both changed. Jesus had come to the point where he accepted suffering as the way to save his people.

Then we are told that a cloud appeared and out of this very cloud a voice spoke: "This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to him!" What really would happen if we all occasionally put aside our attempts to explain Jesus and just listen to him? He can never be superseded. There is a glory about him which once you have seen, you can never describe or explain. You can only reflect upon it in your own unique way as Moses did when he pulled the veil over his face and went in to speak to the Lord.

Prayer: *Compassionate God, you have given us your word by which we might know how to do your will. You too have commanded us to listen to your son Jesus. Help us Lord to listen that all might see with the eyes of faith the kingdom in our midst...*
