SERMON NOTES



While the world looks on in horror at the way Ukraine and its people are being pulverised mercilessly by the forces of a despot, we encounter in today's Gospel Reading from Luke 13 the names and activities of two brutal men who ruled in Jesus' day. We also witness the complete lack of compassion by religious leaders who delighted in grinding down the humble poor. God always has the last word and will call to account all those who cruelly abuse their powers. In today's sermon, we shall explore from Luke 13 something of what Jesus displays concerning God's character. While week by week we rightly celebrate "God's love—God's Grace!" as printed on the Order, Jesus reveals other angles on God, like His holiness and righteousness and who calls people to account for their sin and rebellion. Yet we see at the end of the chapter, the sorrow expressed in His longing to shield people from the consequences of their wrong-doing.

Prayer: *Thanks be to you, Lord Jesus Christ, for all that you reveal of God's character as we continue our Lenten journey with you to the Cross where you display God's love and grace in all its fullness.*
