SERMON NOTES



In our reading, Peter said he was going fishing and six other disciples went with him. The disciples' night of fishing on the Sea of Galilee was fruitless. In the early dawn, they saw someone standing on the shore whom they took to be a stranger. Following his advice, they made a great catch of fish and recognised Jesus.

Jesus had pointed out a place to cast their nets and had prepared to cook fish before the disciples reached shore. These certainly could not have been the figment of someone's imagination; they were not seeing a spirit or a ghost and may well have been a reminder of their calling.

This shows that if you love Christ, you will serve him through a love that reaches out to fish for people and to nurture and feed the children of God.

STILLNESS SERVICE

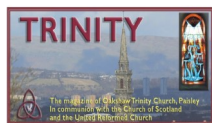
Tuesday between 11am and noon. During this time Rev. Gordon Armstrong and Rev. George Lind will be available.
