SERMON NOTES



In Psalm 67 we have the assurance that God will never abandon us, or leave us. Verses 23 and 24 of today's Gospel reading speak of an abiding place: "My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them." The question the first disciples asked "Where are you staying," in John 1:38, had now been answered. He will live and abide with every person who loves Jesus and keeps his commands.

We read last week, his commands were to love one another and to believe in him. The Holy Spirit will teach Jesus' followers all things; the truth is dynamic and open-ended. Truth is ultimately personal, not propositional. The truth is related to Jesus: the Spirit, he said, "will remind you of everything I have said to you."

Those who live in response to the abiding presence of the Spirit of Christ will know peace. This is not peace as the world knows it – the absence of war and conflict. Rather it is the peace of God that comes from living in harmony with God, with others and oneself.

PRAYER: *Strengthen us, O Lord, for the indwelling of your Spirit, and build up your Church everywhere in faith and love, that the world may be released from bondage and enjoy the perfect peace of your kingdom...*
