SERMON NOTES



We think of happiness and joy as the same quality, and yet there are significant differences. That's why Psalms 97 can begin, "The Lord reigns, let the earth be glad; let the distant shores rejoice" (v. 1).

Bringing things together doesn't make them the same. If they already have some unifying principle, it may or may not be appropriate to bring them together anyway. Jesus prayed, "that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me" (verse 21). We remind ourselves that the disciples were vying for the greatest spot in the Kingdom; Mark and Luke recorded that argument so what sort of unity could there be among this diverse group to take the good news to the world?

The answer is that their unity is to be "in Christ" - and that life starts by trusting in Jesus as Saviour and Lord...

PRAYER: *Lord, help us to recognise your hand in the ordinary things of life that we can truly serve you in the name of Jesus, and bring others to a life with meaning. Give to each of us some of your strong true love, full of patience and kindness...*
