SERMON NOTES



THE TABLE OF HOLY MEMORIES

JOHN 14:17

I believe that as we gather round the Lord's Table; the work of the Holy Spirit awakens many precious memories for all who celebrate this Sacrament. Here we recall experiences that otherwise might be forgotten. Our opportunity to ferret from that past that which will guide, instruct and inspire us keeps our lives centred on noble purposes.

Jesus is reminding his disciples and us to continue to break the bread and to continue to pass the cup in memory of him. After the resurrection, the disciples would often gather in "upper rooms". The Early Church regularly commemorated the Lord's Supper and in no other age has Christ's command been neglected. For each of us there will be individual memories that we associate with this Table. Perhaps at this hour you will remember things that you have forgotten about since you last sat here.

At this table as at no other time in life and worship, we sense the communion of saints, the presence of the Holy Spirit, and a time that can never be forgotten.

Prayer: *Holy and Helping Spirit of Pentecost, forgive the ways we have wronged you and help us to stay awake and ready for you each morning and to be responsive to you as we start our day's work..*
