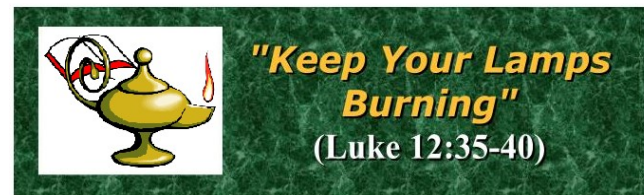

THE BENEDICTION & DRESDEN AMEN



Luke 12 contains a major block of Jesus' teaching about of faith in relationship to the world and the things about us.

1. Verses 32-34 give us a no-frills summary of our aspirations and relationships: 'Do not be afraid, little flock'. Wherever God's rule over life is acknowledged there his kingdom is present. Having trust in God's providence frees us from the cares and anxieties of life.

2. "Sell your possessions and give to the poor (v33)." Not everyone needs to "sell all and give to the poor." The moral here is simply 'don't be greedy.'

3. Faith isn't drawing a long breath and shutting your eyes so that you can believe the impossible. It makes a lot of sense to believe in God. We can't see God with our eyes. But there is plenty of evidence that he is about. "By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible" (verse 3).

The Bible doesn't set out to prove God. It simply begins with a statement that in the beginning, God created...

PRAYER: *Father, sometimes your promises seem almost more than we can believe.*

Give us the faith to hold onto your promises, to laugh at impossibilities, and to believe that all things are possible through Jesus Christ our Lord....

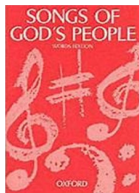
