THE BENEDICTION & DRESDEN AMEN



The words of Luke 12:49-56 make us uncomfortable. However, there are three main points to this reading which all illustrate the crisis that was created when Jesus was born.

The first is that he said: "I have come to bring fire on the earth". The second is Jesus' reference to his rejection and crucifixion when he says: "I have a baptism to undergo..." The third part is the inevitable results of the fire and the baptism; they will bring division in families and upon all the nations of the earth.

By its very nature the gospel divides. But that's not the whole story. The fire also embraces the potential to unite. The fire that Jesus brings is twofold. The first is that where there is a rejection of his gospel, there will be the inevitable judgement and division, which is the point that Isaiah was making. On the other hand, where there is acceptance, there is a union with Christ and with his body...

So my friends, there is a fire that divides and a fire that unites; and the two fires are one...

PRAYER: Lord, help us to look at ourselves and then to look at the world you have given to us and increase the love we have for you and for one another. Grant us a renewal of faith in your promises and in the power of the gospel.

wishes to make a monetary donation to assist those affected by this conflict.






If you can assist, all non-perishable items can be placed in the boxes in the vestibule. Juice is always required. Any items requiring cooking should have a short cooking time.
