Today's readings all speak about the human consciousness of what is right and what is wrong. Paul preaches the value of Christian certainty, and he does that for three very particular reasons.

- 1. He asserts the trustworthiness of Jesus. Paul having met Jesus could know him, he could be sure that in every situation, every experience, every difficulty, that he was in this with Jesus Christ his Saviour and friend.
- 2. Paul preaches that value of Christian certainty because he found that this was a faith that worked for him, a faith that could be tried and found to be true in any day of his life.
- 3. Paul preaches the value of Christian certainty because the gospel makes sense for life and for the universe in which it is to be lived.

Whatever evidence we may accept or ignore, like Paul, I find it impossible to reject the testimony of the Lord Jesus Christ.

<u>RAYER</u>: As we bring together our thoughts and meditations, we wait silently in the shadows to hear with them your words of forgiveness and the confidence to know that we live for the risen Jesus...

Any items requiring cooking should short cooking time. Please note that the Foodbank will be the focus of our Harvest celebration on Sunday 18th September.


▲ FIDDLERS CONCERT:
