The psalmist begins with the conviction that his true security is in God. That doesn't mean we shouldn't seek reasonable protection from all kinds of threats. Refuge is only "under his wings," in safety and comfort; God's faithfulness as "a shield and rampart" (v.4). So the one who trusts in the Lord will not fear.

In Gethsemane we hear Jesus saying, "Do you think I cannot call on my Father, and he will at once put at my disposal more than twelve legions of angels?" (Matthew 26.53) At the crucifixion we hear the taunts again, "Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!" (27.40).

Somehow in our Saviour's suffering we get a different angle on our own. And because of his redemptive suffering, we are protected and rescued after all...

PRAYER: Lord our God, we would live under your redeeming and forgiving grace, and thank you that Jesus did not turn back from a suffering far greater than ours, drinking that cup for our salvation.
