Thoughtful Christians have raised questions about the Resurrection from the very beginning. You can see that in the lesson that was read to us this morning from the Gospel of John.

You could say that Thomas missed the first Easter, and then found it one week later. Why did he miss it? Because he didn't believe it, even though it happened right before his eyes, or very nearly so! In many ways he had the temperament of a sceptic. He was quick to say; show me, prove it, seeing is believing. If we are honest, some of us have trouble believing it, too, especially if we are called upon to live our lives based on that faith.

The God who created life in the first place can create it again. The Resurrection means that God is concerned for us forever and always, unto ages and ages, for all of us. Christianity is not a message which has to be believed, but an experience of faith that becomes a message.






We meet every Tuesday at 2pm in the Lang Hall where you can be assured of a friendly welcome. Thank you to all who supported our Daffodil Tea

which was a great success and raised £267. This Tuesday we will be entertained by Caroline Kyle & Margaret Whyte.


